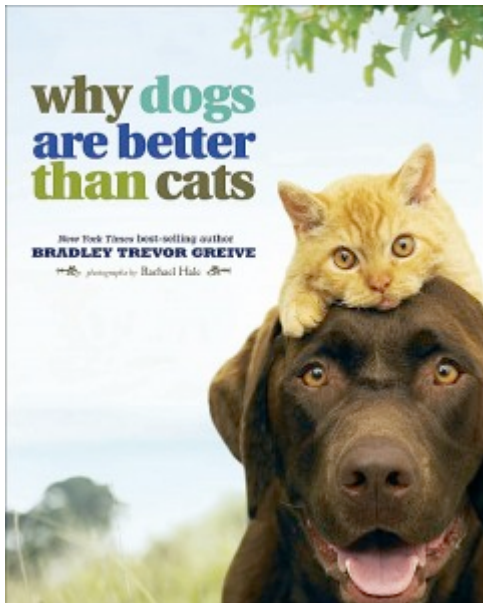


Dogs Vs. Cats? Who Rules?
